Climate Pollution Reduction Grants

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has received \$3 million in grant funding to undertake climate action planning through EPA's **Climate Pollution Reduction Grants (CPRG).** This grant will be managed jointly by DEP's Energy Programs Office and Bureau of Air Quality.

Over the next two years we will be working diligently to develop a Priority Climate Action Plan (PCAP) and Comprehensive Climate Action Plan (CCAP) for

Pennsylvania as deliverables for this grant.

As part the planning efforts, DEP is engaging local government stakeholders within the Commonwealth, as local government agencies are eligible applicants for the \$4.6 billion in Implementation Grants. It is imperative that entities who may wish to apply for implementation grants engage with DEP during this planning phase, as being included in a Priority Climate Action Plan is required to apply for implementation funding.
