Modernizing Property Reassessment: A Priority for County Leaders

County leaders from across Pennsylvania gathered at the Perry County Courthouse on Monday, June 22, 2026, to call for a fair, predictable and sustainable approach to property reassessments.

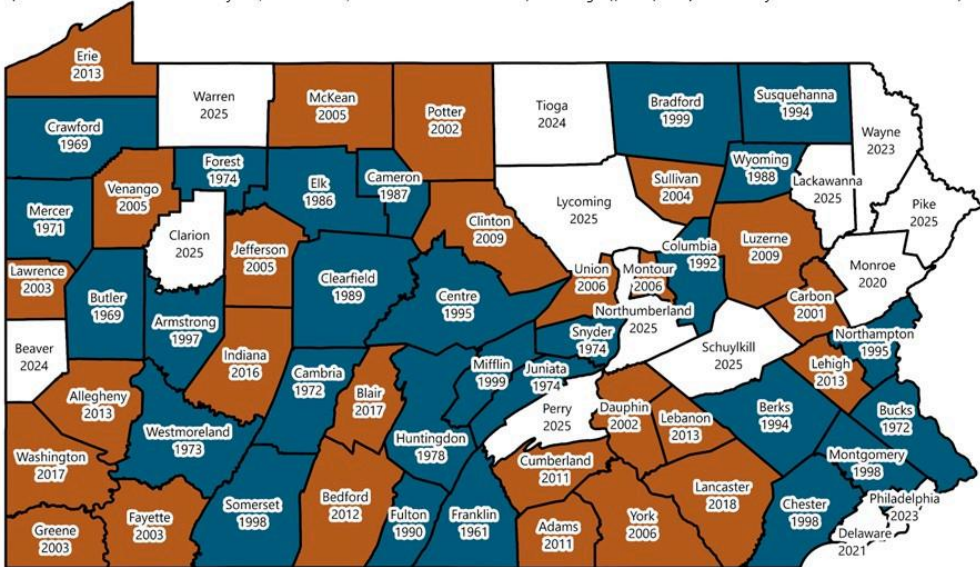
Counties support a phased implementation beginning in 2032, gradually transitioning to recurring reassessments on a staggered regional basis.

The group – that included commissioners and other officials responsible for assessment oversight—emphasized that this effort is not about a state takeover, but about strengthening the state-county partnership by providing the tools, resources and technical support needed to ensure fair and equitable assessments.

OMB Proposes Major Overhaul of Federal Grant Rules

On May 29, 2026, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued a proposed rule to update federal regulations governing grants and financial assistance. If finalized, the changes would affect key county-administered programs, including public safety, transportation, public health, housing and emergency management. Comments are due by July 13, 2026.

Counties are strongly encouraged to review the proposal and submit feedback.

During the conference take part in educational summits that will highlight some of the most pressing trends shaping county government today.

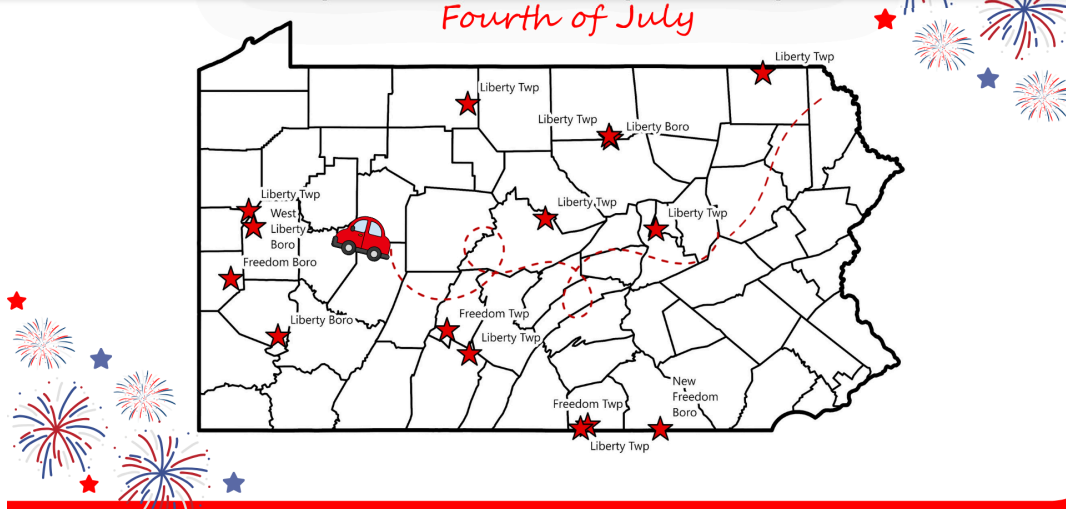
