BEAD Challenge Rebuttal Phase in Process

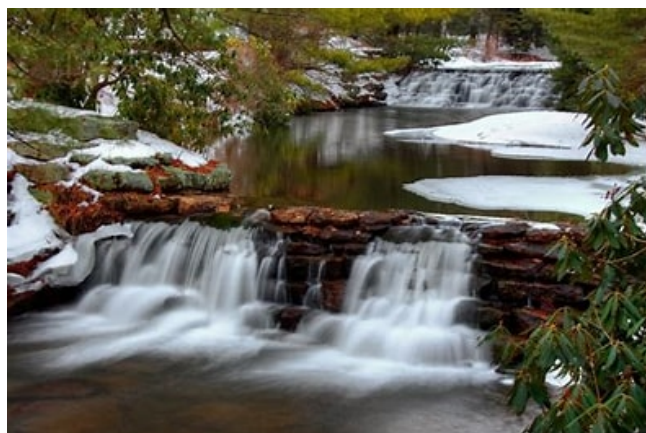
The Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority (PBDA) BEAD Rebuttal Window is open until June 22, 2024.

Counties eligible for the challenge process but not registered must complete a **registration** before submitting a rebuttal.

Municipal Opportunities for Retrofits and Energy Efficiency (MORE)

The Pennsylvania Energy Development Authority is launching the MORE Program under the Energy Accelerator Program, offering grants and loans to municipal governments (counties, towns, cities, townships, authorities, and boroughs) not eligible for an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG).

Details:

- \$1.8 million in first-come, first-served grants available until October 25, 2024.
- \$1 million of the grants is reserved for priority applicants until August 30, 2024
- The MORE Loan will remain open while funds last.

Local governments are encouraged to apply early. The [MORE Program](#) website will be regularly updated with resources and information.

Watershed Stormwater Management Plan Grants

The Department of Environmental Protection invites eligible counties to apply for funding to develop or revise watershed stormwater management plans under the Commonwealth's Storm Water Management Act.

Grant applications and attachments must be submitted online through the Commonwealth's Electronic Single Application [website](#). Applications will be accepted through 11:59 p.m. on Friday, August 30, 2024. Additional information is available on the [Pennsylvania Bulletin](#).
