



Pennsylvania and Delinguency

Stakeholder Survey: Commission on Crime Office of Gun Violence **Prevention**

The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinguency (PCCD) has reestablished the Office of Gun Violence and Protection. It seeks input from community stakeholders to better understand the impact of gun violence across Pennsylvania communities.

They have developed a survey that asks for ideas about policies, programs, and how funding should be used to help reduce gun violence in Pennsylvania.

Please take a few minutes to fill out the survey.

This input will be instrumental in shaping the work of the Office as it works to develop a comprehensive gun violence reduction strategy for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Your feedback will also help inform planning efforts on how Pennsylvania can leverage federal Byrne State Crisis Intervention Program (SCIP) funding administered by PCCD – a funding stream that addresses the intersections of gun violence with behavioral health crises and other issues.



2023 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Application Now Open

The Commonwealth has announced that FEMA and the CISA have approved the Commonwealth's implementation of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP).

The Commonwealth will allocate 80% of the SLCGP funds, totaling \$8,371,039, to support four projects in the Commonwealth Cybersecurity Plan. The Commonwealth's Cybersecurity Planning Committee has approved these projects.

If you participated in the FFY2022 grant application for Project 1 or Project 2, you must re-apply for those services under FFY2023 and apply for any new projects you would like to participate in.

The four projects are:

- 1) Intrusion Detection Service MS-ISAC Albert Sensors
- 2) Security Awareness Service Cofense
- 3) Cyber Exposure Management and Asset Intelligence Platform ARMIS
- 4) Vulnerability Management Solution Tenable.
