

The Program

This training focuses on improving participants' communication, management, and leadership skills.

Participants: Open to the CCAP voting members in each county: county commissioners or council members, chief clerks, county administrators, and solicitors. Key county leaders and department heads may apply by including one written letter of support from their county commissioner/council member.

Application: Completion of the online application at www.pacounties.org/education/cel, and submission of a resume and vision statement, is required by January 31, 2023. Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee by February 28, 2023. Participation is available to one eligible person per county per year, with a maximum of 12 participants per year.

The Program: This is a two and a half-day program offered annually. See additional programming details in this brochure. Participants will receive materials and assessments in advance to be completed prior to the program start date.

Day One: The DISC Model and Stages of Leadership

Day Two: Leading Change, The Four Conversations, Media Management, Crisis Communication

Day Three: Problem Solving and Decision Making

Optional: Ongoing coaching is available; details will be provided to participants upon completion of the program. Post program coaching is provided by staff of The Professional Edge, Inc. at an additional cost.

Cost: \$900 per person includes course registration and program materials, overnight accommodations for three nights, continental breakfast and lunch for three days, and an evening event. Final deadline for payments is April 14, 2023.

APPLICATION

All participants are required to submit an online application, as well as a resume and vision statement. Completion of the online application (www.pacounties.org/education/cel) is required by January 31, 2023. Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee by February 28, 2023.

Participation is available to one eligible person per county per year, with a maximum of 12 participants per year. Eligible participants are the CCAP voting members in each county: county commissioners, council members, chief clerks, county administrators, and solicitors. Key county leaders and department heads may apply by including one written letter of support from their county commissioner/council member in addition to the full application.

COST

The tuition for the CEL program is \$900 per person which includes course registration and program materials, overnight accommodations for three nights, continental breakfast and lunch for three days, and an evening event. Participants will be notified of their acceptance into the program by February 28, 2023 and will be invoiced at that time. Final payment for participation is due in full by April 14, 2023. Payment plans are available upon request.



ACADEMY CREDIT

Participants who complete the full CEL program will also be afforded credit for the Leadership, Management and Decision Making core course for the Academy for Excellence in County Government required coursework.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to the nature of the program, and advance materials purchased and sent to all participants in early spring, written notification of cancellation must be sent to tsnovel@pacounties.org by 4 p.m. on March 15, 2023 to avoid penalty. Valid cancellations received in writing by 4 p.m. on April 14, 2023 are subject to an administrative charge of 25 percent of the program cost (\$225); cancellations received by 4 p.m. May 15, 2023 are subject to an administrative charge of 50 percent of the program cost (\$450). All refunds are issued via check. There are no refunds for cancellations received after 4 p.m. on May 15, 2023.
