PCCD announces \$7M JAG Grant

PCCD announced the availability of approximately \$7 million in federal [Byrne Justice Assistance Grant \(JAG\) funds](#). Eligible applicants include local units of government (including counties) and non-profit organizations. PCCD expects to fund approximately 30-35 grants with budgets not to exceed \$250,000 over a two-year project period.
