New Funding Opportunity from YFTI

The University of Pittsburgh's Youth and Family Training Institute (YFTI) is partnering with the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS) Bureau of Children's Behavioral Health Services and Bureau of Policy, Planning & Program Development to develop and launch a two-year pilot program.

This initiative will define, develop, and evaluate the role of the Family Navigator at up to six sites across Pennsylvania. The pilot aims to test the effectiveness of family navigator models for children, youth, and young adults (CYYA) with serious emotional disturbances (SED), promoting early access, engagement, and coordination of mental health services for CYYA aged 5-21 and their family caregivers.

- Up to six sites across the Commonwealth will receive up to \$250,000 each year for the 2-year pilot.
- Counties, provider organizations, health facilities, or other public, private or non-profit entities within Pennsylvania that serve children, youth and young adults aged 5-21 are eligible to apply.
- A diversity of sites is being sought in various contexts such as setting (urban, suburban, rural) and target population.

Applications are due on or before **March 28th, 2025**. Selected sites will be notified in writing by April 25, 2025.
