## PCCD Funding Announcement Notification

PCCD has announced the availability of grant funding to support the training of medical and mental healthcare providers who treat children and/or adults who were

sexually abused as children under [Act 1 of 2013](#).

A total of \$200,000 in Endowment Act funding is being announced to support this initiative. This is a competitive award process. PCCD expects to fund approximately four projects with budgets not to exceed \$50,000 over the 2-year project period.

## PAYS Data and Related Trainings Available



The 2023 [Pennsylvania Youth Survey \(PAYS\)](#), conducted by the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD), is now available.

The PAYS surveys school students in the 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th grades to learn about their behavior, attitudes and knowledge concerning alcohol, tobacco, other drugs and violence.

This data can be helpful in understanding community needs and future programming in your county.

Additionally, the Evidence-based Prevention and Intervention Support (EPIS) cohort within Penn State has developed free online courses and resources through their [Prevention Learning Portal \(PLP\)](#) to understand the PAYS and other community-level data. Counties are encouraged to visit the PLP for further information, related resources and other online tools.
